

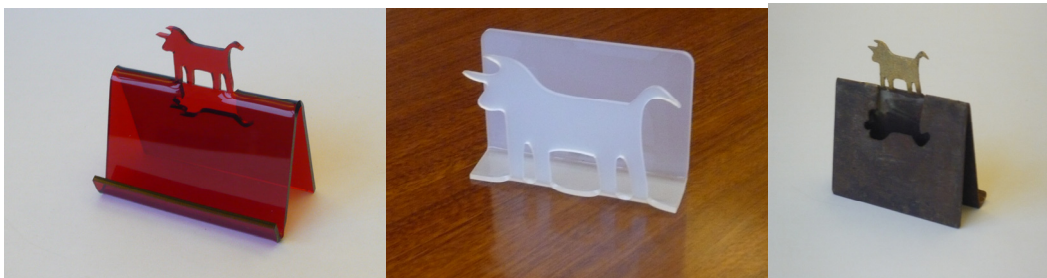
## MUSEE NATIONAL DE BEYROUTH & ANA CORBERO'

The National Museum of Beirut is the best museum of Phoenician art in the World. It has also survived, war and numerous bombings, bravely preserving precious antiquities and the legacy of ancient peoples. The following designs were created for the National Museum's 'Designers' Exhibition of 2005.



### PERFUME BOTTLE PENDANT

The silver plated bronze bottle pendant was inspired from a 700 AD, much larger glass bottle in the museum. The pendant can contain perfume or oil, and includes a handy applicator screw top. It is supplied with a red silk cord.



### BULL

VISITING CARD HOLDER PLEXI / NAPKIN HOLDER / VISITING CARD HOLDER STEEL

The bull design was inspired by a small bronze statuette dating from 2500AD. The desk visiting card holders, the napkin holders and the book holders are all available in plexiglass of various colours, or oxidized steel, with or without 23K gold leaf detail.
